Through your hard work and attainment of the Greenhand, Chapter, and State FFA Degrees, you are eligible to apply for your American FFA Degree. This is the highest degree the National FFA Organization can bestow upon its members. By earning this degree, you will be recognized for your hard work in your Supervised Agricultural Experience program and become more marketable for both college scholarships and future employment.

To be eligible to receive the American FFA Degree members must meet certain requirements, update your records, and complete the application available on AET. The record book and application are all done through our record book program www.TheAET.com. If you forgot your password we can reset it for you. It is a much simpler process than the State FFA Degree, and we are still here to help you!

April 15 - Electronic versions of members applications submitted for review and approval to Oregon FFA.

Please get these done early so that reviewers have adequate time to review them and get back to you.

May 20 - To submit your final american degrees to advisors.

If you are interested in applying for an [American Star Award](#), the same process and due as above should be followed for that application.

You will be recognized at our FFA Banquet following the convention that you receive your degree. We are also attending the National FFA Convention this fall of 2020, and if you receive your American Degree you will be able to attend the convention and receive your degree there (optional). If you are interested in attending we encourage you to get involved with our chapter fundraisers for the trip so you can offset your cost.

Please let us know if you have any questions about this process. We were planning on scheduling a workday in April, but with the COVID-19 restrictions we may not be able to do this in person - but we can do something virtually.

Please let an advisor know of your intentions to apply for your American FFA Degree as soon as possible.
